Questions	Source X	Source A	Source B
What does the caption on the poster say?	<i>e.g. Men of Britain! Will you stand for this? 78 Women & Children killed...ENLIST NOW</i>		
What is happening in the poster?	<i>The poster shows a picture of what appears to be a bombed house with a small girl outside holding a baby. The caption underneath explains that it was the home of a family.</i>		
What is the main aim of the poster?	<i>I think the aim of this poster is to show people the destruction the German's are causing and to encourage men to join the army to seek revenge</i>		
How does the poster achieve this aim?	<i>The poster achieves this aim by using the sadness of the image to motivate the reader to be emotionally attached. Once the reader is suitable shocked, the words ENLIST NOW show the reader what he can do to prevent this happening</i>		
How persuasive is this poster? Mark out of 5	<i>4/5 - Quite Persuasive as it gives a lot of information which makes it seem official and the picture and captions give you little choice but to agree – sign up!</i>
